Progress

- 2016 • All Provinces and Territories committed to not claw back CCB from families receiving social assistance 
- 2017 • CCB was fully indexed to inflation as of July 2018 
- 2018 • The budget dedicates \$17 million to improve CCB uptake for on reserve and urban Indigenous families 

What's Next?

- Ensure parent/s' immigration status does not effect children's eligibility for the CCB 
- Increase CCB base to half child poverty by 2020
