

Time to Dig Deep to Raise Our Kids:

*Manitoba Child and Family Poverty Rate Dips Slightly
but Depth of Poverty Deepens*

From 2020–2023 the depth of poverty for Manitoba’s families increased.

Children in Manitoba living in single parent families were the most likely of any Canadian jurisdiction to live in poverty at 62.5%.

Year after year, 3 of the 10 federal ridings with the highest rates of child poverty were in Manitoba.

85,790

Manitoba children were living in poverty.

Children living in poverty are less school-ready, and score lower in numeracy, reading and writing comprehension, and student engagement than children in higher-income homes.

Manitoba’s strategy must have a bold target and timeline:

50% reduction by 2028
